

# **Researchers Survey Report KALRO**

## **Academic qualification**

A total of 135 researchers responded to the researcher's survey questionnaire on the 16<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at KALRO conference hall. Out of 135 researchers who responded, 60 (44.4%) were PhD holders, 67 (49.6%) were master's graduates while 8 (5.9%) were bachelor degree holders.

#### **Research ICT Services**

The results show that researchers require research ICT services to support their research work. The top priority research ICT services that KALRO researches need are: High speed internet /WiFi, Scientific software (for computing, analysis and visualization), Research data storage and open research data repositories. The above ICT services scores 102 (77.8%), 98 (74.8%), 82 (62.6%) and 42 (32.1%) respectively. Other KALRO researchers needs include High Performance Computing (HPC) and Video /web conferencing. Most researchers, 129 (97.7%), 117 (88.6%) and 58 (43.9%) uses personal/office computer, external disk drive and drobox respectively as the main storage platform for research data.

## **Research Productivity, Funding and Training**

KALRO researchers (114) have published a total 237 research papers in the last 2 years; this translates to approximately 2 papers per researcher in the last two years. On the other hand, 115 (86.5%) of researchers collaborate with other researchers either nationally or internationally while 18 (13.5%) neither collaborate nationally or internationally. The priority sources of research funding for KALRO researchers are: NRF, USAID, KALRO (Institution), GoK, World Bank and European Commission(EU). According to the researchers from KALRO, the top priority areas where training is required are: Use of KENET free web conferencing

platform, Research and data analysis and access to external /global HPC and/or Grid Computing facilities.
