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Introduction

Kenya Education Network KENET has a web conferencing platform running on BigBlueButton BBB and is free to all its member institutions. The platform can be integrated with Learning Management System such as Moodle to support real-time sessions with instructors, faculty and learners.

This guide is designed to help System/LMS administrators to use BigBlueButton plugin in Moodle LMS and link it to the KENET Web conference platform via a shared secret key and URL.

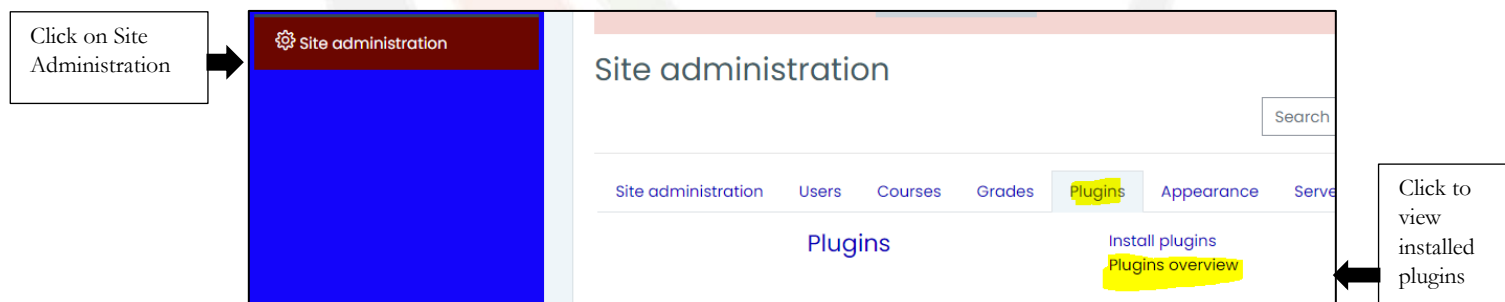
Getting Started

The BigBlueButton plugin is included **as a core feature in Moodle 4.0 and all newer versions**. However, its not automatically enabled and configured for use. This, therefore, requires one to enable the plugin and configure it by providing necessary credentials such as the URL and secret key.

Enable BigBlueButton Plugin in Moodle.

To verify that the plugin is successfully installed and enabled in Moodle:

1. Go back to “**Site Administration.**” And from there
2. Select “**Plugins.**” Click on “**Plugins overview**” link.



Confirm if the plugin is available. If available, you can now allow faculty to create their virtual classes in Moodle LMS.

3. Click on the **Settings** Action Feature to configure your BBB plugin where you will be required to share the **BigBlueButton Server URL** and **BigBlueButton Shared Secret Key**.
4. Worry not, The BigBlueButton plugin in Moodle LMS may be configured for it to use the KENET BigBlueButton Servers via **BigBlueButton Server URL** and **BigBlueButton Shared Secret Key**.

Integration of BigBlueButton plugin with KENET Web Conference Platform.

1. Member institutions should formally request KENET for the BigBlueButton Server URL and BigBlueButton Shared Secret Key for their BigBlueButton plugin to work seamlessly with their Moodle LMS.
2. Once you receive the server URL and shared secret key from KENET, just fill the two required fields.

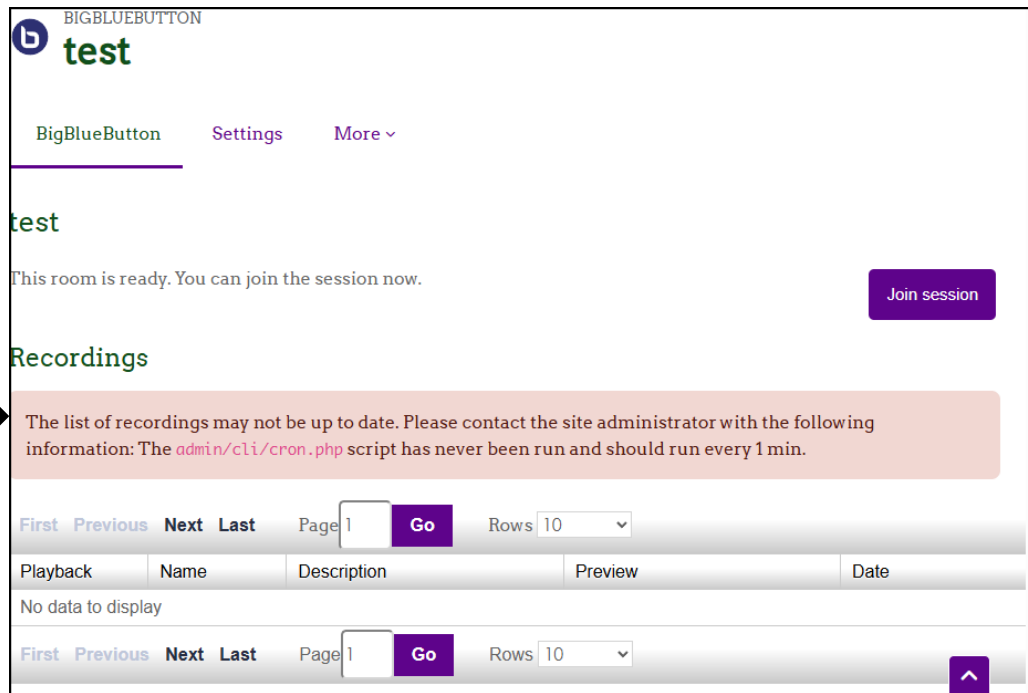

Enabling Cronjob

1. SSH to your server
2. `$ sudo crontab -u www-data -e`
 - Add the following line to the file

```
***** /usr/bin/php /var/www/html/moodle/admin/cli/cron.php >/dev/null
```

3. `$ sudo systemctl restart cron.service`

Once enabled, the cron job will automatically run Moodle's scheduled tasks, ensuring features like recordings and notifications function properly.
